South Australia's "The Audreys" feature the witty worded "Audreys" Collins on melodic, harmonica and acoustic. Brian Goodie on acoustic neo-folk, guitar and fiddle. Mike G on violin and mandolin, Gordon Gray on double bass and fiddle. Luke on drums.

Three debut albums, "Between Last Night and Us", was released in February 2006 to rave reviews and an ARIA nomination. Their singles, "Oh Honey", "You and Steve McQueen" and "Don't Change", have been heard on airwaves throughout the country.

The group has hit the road to promote the album, with performances at clubs around the country and appearances at festivals such as A Day on the Green, Woodford, Red Hill Barossa Festival, Post Party Folk Festival, The Great Escape and The East Coast Blues and Roots Festival.

"The Audreys" then flew to Texas to perform at the North American Folk Alliance Convention, where they were

"The Audreys" toured through Europe and Canada through May, June and July on an epic trip that took in England, Scotland, Wales, France, Belgium, Russia and Canada's East Coast.

with the energetic, entertaining and unforgettable at their show at the West Gippsland Arts Centre on May 27 at 8pm.
